Appearing: KartSport New Zealand was represented by Warrick Parkes, National Technical Officer.
The Appellant, Brendon Polaschek for Ayden Polaschek, chose not to appear before the Appeal Board as per his communication dated 03 August 2015.

Process: Email communication from Brendon Polaschek dated 03 August 2015 was tabled and considered.
Warrick Parkes presented and spoke to a report from the recently retired National Technical Officer, Colin Smith, detailing his findings that the barrel was not compliant with Rule N1.7.

Outcome: The Appeal Board determined that the Appeal is unsuccessful and that decision of the event Stewards be upheld. IE the exclusion of Ayden Polaschek from the Junior 100cc Yamaha class classification.

Costs: The Appeal Board determined not to award costs.
