Supplementary Rules

Event Status

This is a single event run over 1 day to the regulations, codes, rules, procedures and specifications of KartSport New Zealand.

1. Entry Details

Entries must be either on-line, or on the official entry form and accompanied by the correct entry fees

Official closing date for the early entries is 5pm Friday 15th of June 2018

Classes may be cancelled due to not achieving minimum entries (6 per class) by early entry closing date.

Late entries will be accepted for confirmed classes until 5pm 29th June only if accompanied by the appropriate late entry fee.

Entry forms must include the signature of the respective School Principal or Sports Co-ordinator.

2. Eligibility

This event is restricted to T1 drivers .

As per KartSport New Zealand Rule P2.14 -

Enrolled full-time at school in year 9 or above (if competing for Secondary School)

Under 19 years of age on 1 January in the year of competition.

Or attending full time primary (year 1 to year 6) or intermediate (Year 7 and Year 8).

3. Race Programme

Thursday: Testing.

Friday: Testing and Tyre & Engine Seal Distribution.

Saturday, Cadet ROK, Vortex Mini Rok, Vortex ROK DVS Junior, 100cc Junior Yamaha, 125cc Rotax Max Junior, Vortex ROK DVS, 100cc Yamaha, 125cc Rotax Max Light

The Vortex ROK DVS classes will be combined on track with their respective 100cc Yamaha classes.

The Vortex ROK DVS classes will run off the FRONT of their respective Junior & Senior 100cc Yamaha fields with separate results for each class.

This event will run to a published timetable that will be established following the close of entries on the 15th of June 2018.

4. Race Format

As per KartSport New Zealand Rule P2.3

First 4 heats, predetermined grid system. 5th Heat lowest points to the front. Competitors' worst performance is now dropped and the class champion is decided over the best 4 heats.

National points system is 1 point for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, etc.

Race Distances = 12 laps

Inter-School Teams Competition and Bruce McLaren Awards as per Rule P2.16

5. Decals

Competitors may be required to display sponsors stickers in the designated area of the kart.

6. Dry Tyre Distribution

During the whole of the competition all classes must only use the DRY tyres formally allocated to them under the control of the officials of the event. Competitors must purchase a voucher for a full set of DRY tyres from their chosen supplier and will uplift the tyres at the track during formal distribution on Friday the 13th of July 2018 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm

Competitors are to supply their own WET tyres which will be marked/scanned if/when first used at this event.

7. Dry Tyre Use

From Heat one, and for the first time dry tyres are used, karts must present to their respective out grids with their allocated, unused (Green) dry tyres.

8. Engine Sealing

Engines will be sealed as per rule L9. Seals will be distributed at the same time as dry tyre distribution. Fitting instructions will be included with the seals. Engine seals must be correctly attached prior to the entry of the out grid for Heat one.

9. Push Back Nose Cones

From the commencement of Heat one to the conclusion of Heat Five, each competitor must enter the out grid area with the nose cone detached from their kart. The pit crew member or the competitor themselves must mount the nose cone in the out grid area under the supervision of a Judge of Fact – either a Race Official, Technical Officer or other appointee.
The decision of the out grid Judge of Fact as to the correct mounting (or not) or the conformity of the nose cone & fittings **cannot be protested**. Note specific requirements under Rule K1.42

10. Access To The Out Grid

Starting with the commencement of tuning runs, only one crew member per kart will be permitted into the secure out grid. An extra crew member may help with lifting the kart and is then required to exit the out grid.

11. Documentation, Gear Check and Scrutineering

Random scrutineering, confirmation of entry and gear check as per timetable

12. Drivers Briefing

Will be conducted on Saturday in the out grid area or other such place as may be notified. All driver's and signed in parents/ legal guardians must attend drivers briefing.

13. Engine Warm Up Area

A designated area will be assigned to be used for the warming up of engines.

14. Official Notice Board

The notice board is situated on the wall outside the weigh in area behind the Race Secretary's office. Notices, results and/or information may not be removed from the board without the authority of a KartSport New Zealand Official.

15. School Identification

School identification on karts and racing apparel is encouraged. All competitors are required to wear school apparel at the prize giving. Minimum requirement: School track suit or school sweatshirt or T-shirt (plus cap if available) as per Rule P2.18.

16. 2018 Rok Cup NZ

Points from this event will be allocated to Round 4 of the 2018 Rok Cup.
Refer Addendum For Details And Conditions.

17. School Absence

Competitors must advise their School of their participation in the Schools sanctioned event. This means they will not be marked as absent on the days away but rather "E'd" as a school approved sports event

Vortex ROK DVS Junior Class Prizes

The confirmed first and second placed drivers of the Vortex ROK DVS Junior class will be entitled to the following prize:

- Entry fee for the ROK Cup International Final to be held on 10-13 October 2018 at the South Garda Karting circuit, Lonato, Italy.
- Supply of complete kart (OTK brand) and Vortex engine, race tyres, free paddock space and tent.
- Hotel accommodation and lunch for the race days for the driver.
- Return airfare (Auckland-Milan) for the driver (Maximum value \$2,500 incl GST). Provided with support from the KartSport/Lascom Motorsport/Dunlop International Travel Fund.
- Share of the KartSport/Motul NZ Travel Fund.

These prizes are subject to the following conditions:

- *Competitors must be racing on a KartSport New Zealand Competition Licence and be resident in NZ.*
- *Competitors must arrange appropriate Racing Licence and Racing Visa via KartSport New Zealand.*
- *Competitors must supply appropriate racing apparel which meets current CIK-FIA karting regulations (note Junior helmet requirements).*
- *Competitors and mechanics must arrange valid passports and travel Visas required for international travel to Italy.*
- *The respective mechanics must be over 18 years on 1-10-18 and receive KartSport New Zealand's written approval.*
- *The respective mechanics must be assigned as the respective guardians for the period of the trip/competition.*
- *KartSport New Zealand and Vortex reserve the right to withhold the prize or reallocate the prize should the initial recipient(s) have his/her NZ Competition Licence suspended or cancelled after the 2018 National Schools Championships and before the 2018 ROK Cup International Final.*
- *Note: KartSport New Zealand Rule Q4.9 applies. ROK Cup International Finals prizes are awarded on a "use it or lose it" basis.*
