Long a favourite with the country's top level karters, the **CIK Trophy of New Zealand** meeting is back on the competition calendar in 2019, set to be hosted at one of its former homes, the [KartSport Hamilton](#) club's Speedworks Raceway facility over the January 19-20 weekend.

The big attraction for kiwi competitors in the **senior Vortex ROK DVS** class will be the two entries, including kart, engine and travel package, to the annual [ROK Cup International](#) meeting in Italy in November 2019 for the class winner and runner-up at the event.
