On Track with Colin Harris

SAFETY -- I want to start my first **E-Line** contribution to you all as the National Steward by asking the people who rush to assist at the scene of an on track incident with the best of intentions, particularly where our younger drivers are involved, that they just pause for a second before they take action and avoid what may be a minor injury to the driver becoming a serious injury. If the driver eg. cannot remove his/her helmet, undo the strap if you must but **DO NOT REMOVE** the helmet until the First Aid person is with you. Last year at one of our major events I witnessed (a parent?) pull a young driver out of his kart without first checking to see if the driver was injured.

Please if you find yourself attending an incident just pause, take a deep breath, assess the situation and then render appropriate assistance.
