Under the leadership of the new *Competitions Manager*, a team including National Technical Officer, National Steward, Permit Manager and Academy Director will work together to improve the management, communication and delivery of key customer focused support for members and Clubs nationwide.



The new structure focused clearly on *Competitions Management Excellence* will provide significantly enhanced support and direction for all divisions creating a strong high performance, member friendly culture.

This restructure has taken some significant load off the previous National Steward role and now provides a much more supportive environment in which an applicant can grow and develop and enhance both their own skills and the outcomes for competitors and Race Officials.



Needless to say Members and Clubs still urgently require the services of a National Steward albeit in this new more structured and cohesive team structure.
