The KartSport New Zealand National Technical Officer wishes to remind all Rotax Max competitors of the requirements of Rule N12.2 .

*"Only genuine Rotax components that are specifically designed and supplied for the FR 125 engine may be used in or on the engine and its ancillaries".*

Right Karts have confirmed and the Rotax parts lists supports the fact, that Rotax do not manufacture or supply a 10 tooth sprocket.

**Therefore any 'after market' 10 tooth sprocket is illegal.**



## Reminders



- If you are purchasing a new race suit make sure it complies with Rule G3.2 "new rule applicable **1-1-12.**" KartSport New Zealand is pleased to report that **JPC Motorsport**, Christchurch (phone 03-383 3353) has been issued with the first KartSport New Zealand Approval Code Label issued under Rule G3.2 Option 2 for locally made race suits.



- **Licence Number.** If you wish to retain your Licence Number you must send your current Licence back for renewal before it expires. If your Renewal is received after your Licence has expired there is no guarantee that your previous Licence number will still be available.



- Please don't forget to include a **valid Club Membership Card** with your Renewal.
