



## KartSport New Zealand Inquiry Report

### 2014 NI Sprint Championships Cadet ROK ref Rule 3.7

- Venue:** KartSport New Zealand Office, Auckland
- Date:** 20<sup>th</sup> December 2014 commencing at 11-00am
- Terms of Reference:** At the request of the Stewards of the Event review the recorded breaches of Rule K3.7 (also Ref Rule L6) by Cadet ROK kart numbers: NS, 13, 17, 18, 20, 44, 47, and 81 at KartSport Rotorua on 26-10-14. If breach(es) confirmed, to impose appropriate penalty(s).
- Process:** All competitors were served with respective Forms of Complaint prior to the Hearing.  
Competitors Dylan Grant #20 and Ryan Hancock #81 accepted the suggested penalty (DQ from Cadet ROK) prior to the Hearing.  
Guardian for Gemma Winters #44 failed to appear at the Hearing.  
Connor Davison #NS, Asten Addy #13, Mitchell Frazer #17, Luke Thompson #18 and Mason Potter #47 were represented by their respective guardians who appeared, one by one, before the Panel. L Thompson's guardian presented a witness.  
KartSport New Zealand was represented by Competitions Manager, John Lennox who presented witness statements and a written interpretation of Rule K3.7 by the National Technical Officer, provided as per Regulation B6.  
All parties confirmed a full and fair hearing was conducted.
- Outcomes:** The Panel found in all cases, including G Winters, that the respective karts were in breach of Rule K3.7.
- Penalties Imposed:** That a penalty of disqualification from the Cadet ROK class be applied to Connor Davison #NS, Asten Addy #13, Mitchell Frazer #17, Luke Thompson #18, Gemma Winters #44 and Mason Potter #47.
- The Outcome above and right of Appeal was notified verbally to all guardians present at the conclusion of the Hearing.
